Statement

El PASO, Texas - On Oct. 4, 2022, at approximately 12:45 p.m., U.S. Border Patrol Agents assigned to the Ysleta Border Patrol Station, were involved in a shooting incident at the Ysleta Station. One person in custody was shot and transported to a local hospital for evaluation and treatment. Investigative personnel including the Federal Bureau of Investigations, The El Paso Police Department and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection's Office of Professional Responsibility are on-scene at this time.

OPR is reviewing the incident. Additional information will be shared as it becomes available. Note that the FBI is the lead investigative agency on this matter.
