ORDER

On this date came on to be heard the Motion to Reduce Sentence of Imprisonment Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) of JOSE RODOLFO ESCAJEDA, No. 69445-280. See ECF 326

In this Motion, Escajeda seeks a reduction of sentence by two levels based on Amendment 782. The Court notes that on August 18, 2016, this Court entered an Order Regarding Motion for Sentence Reduction Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) which DENIED such a request. In its prior review of this matter, the Court determined that, based on the amount of drugs for which Escajeda was held accountable, the Total Offense Level of 43 remained unchanged. Ecf 294 For that and various other reasons, a sentence reduction is not applicable and the Court is of the opinion that Escajeda’s Motion should be DENIED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Escajeda’s Motion to Reduce Sentence of Imprisonment Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) is **DENIED**.
